



## **2020-2021 Statement for First Nine Weeks (K-12th)**

Believing that daily personal interaction between our teachers and students is the best educational option, the Board of Directors has approved a plan for reopening Southeastern Christian Academy on August 17th, 2020. We can best fulfill our goals of learning aimed at excellence, maximizing potential and training Warriors for Christ when we are on campus and interacting as a school community. Our plan is based on the most current medical information from the North Carolina Department of Public Health, our community and our faculty and staff task forces. As we progress through the year, health and safety will be our number one priority, while maintaining the best learning environment possible.

- 1. Students will return to a 5-day a week in-person learning environment beginning August 17th, 2020**
- 2. Morning Drop-Off**
  1. Regular start times
  2. Students may enter building at 7:45am - tardy bell at 8:10am
  3. Student temperatures will be taken in the car at drop-off
  4. Parents remain in vehicles
  5. All students entering the building will wear masks until they reach their desk
- 3. Masks**
  1. All students will wear masks for arrival, dismissal, transitions, and common areas
  2. Where social distancing is not possible, masks will be worn
  3. Teachers will wear face coverings at all times
  4. Masks are not restricted by dress code
  5. Face shields are not an option
  6. Any medical exemptions must be issued in writing by a medical doctor
- 4. In The Classroom**
  1. Upon arrival students will sanitize hands
  2. All belongings will be kept at students' desk
  3. No lockers will be used
  4. Modified classroom procedures to accommodate social distancing
  5. Sharing materials is not permitted
  6. Students will remain in homerooms
  7. Subject teachers in upper grade levels will rotate
- 5. Lunch**
  1. All students will eat lunch in classrooms
  2. Subway and Papa Johns will be suspended
  3. Parents/deliveries are not permitted for student lunches
  4. Vending machines will not be accessible
- 6. Cleaning**
  1. Additional daily cleaning throughout the school building

2. Bathrooms sanitized after each class use
3. End of day sanitizing
4. Weekly deep cleaning

#### **7. Dismissal Schedule**

1. 1:30pm High School
2. 1:45pm Middle School
3. 2:00pm Grades 3rd, 4th, & 5th
4. 2:15pm Grades K, 1st, & 2nd
5. All students not picked-up within 15 minutes of their dismissal time will be promptly checked-in to after-school care
6. Each student must be picked up during allotted time frame
7. Families with multiple students must adhere to dismissal schedule

#### **8. After-school Care**

1. Modified after-school procedures to accommodate social distancing
2. After-school closes at 5:15pm
3. \$10 per day charge for all students checked-in

#### **9. Athletics**

1. Information on individual sports will be released to team members

Much new information is begin released indicating that the risk of contracting COVID-19 remains very low in children. Implementation of several coordinated plans can greatly reduce the risk. We will continue to work diligently to remain flexible and clear about new information that is helpful to decision making as it relates to the safety of all.
